The Materials Planning & Procurement Team Leader will be responsible for providing strategic leadership and direction to the site Materials Planning and Procurement functions. This individual will implement effective planning tools with a focus on reducing inventory and maximizing pull systems, as well as transition contracts to long-term agreements. This leader will determine order/inventory requirements based on information contained in ERP/MRP systems and implement site's deflationary plan as well as aerospace group metrics.

Responsibilities:

1. Oversight for master production schedule to achieve division objectives for customer service, inventory levels, and configuration management. Plans, prepares, issues, and controls production schedules and material requirements to ensure a controlled flow of approved materials timed to meet production requirements.
2. Manage inventory levels and maximize the pull system using PFEP.
3. Negotiate pricing for castings, machined parts, electronics, sub-assemblies, and miscellaneous piece parts.
4. Provide presentations to management, subordinates, and customers regarding the status of materials and procurement activities.
5. Provide daily supervision to the Materials & Procurement Team.
